On unique community-based Expedition Field Courses, students work with and learn from local people about the challenges and benefits of living sustainably. Spend time living and learning in the villages, rivers, forests, islands and coasts of Thailand while studying the link between culture and ecology. Academically challenging and intensely experiential, each course at ISDSI focuses on a specific community and ecosystem, from the tribal people and forested mountains of Northern Thailand to the fishing communities and islands of the Andaman Sea.

Location:	Based in Chiang Mai, Northern Thailand, but with courses throughout the country.
Program length:	1 semester (17 weeks consisting of 1 week orientation and 4 month long block courses). A full year option is available.
Amount of credit:	16 semester credits
Eligibility / Requirements:	Enrolled in a US college or university, minimum 3.0 GPA
Application deadline:	Deadline for the fall semester in March, for the spring semester in September. See website for exact dates.
